

How to Search the Disaster Response Registry

Before You Start:

SAM.gov is the official **FREE U.S. government-operated website** where entities register to conduct business with the government. There is NO charge to register or maintain your entity registration record in SAM.gov.

What is the Disaster Response Registry?

When national emergencies or disasters such as floods and hurricanes occur, supplies and services need to be procured and rushed to the affected area quickly. To expedite this process, the SAM.gov Disaster Response Registry shows contractors willing to provide debris removal, distribution of supplies, reconstruction, and other disaster or emergency relief supplies and/or services.

Do I need to log in to search Disaster Response Registry data?

Yes, you need to log in to view all entity information in SAM.gov. No roles are required for the logged in user to view publicly available information.

What information does the Disaster Response Registry collect?

SAM.gov collects two pieces of information from contractors wanting to be listed in the registry:

- **Bonding Level (if applicable):** A bond is a written instrument executed by a bidder or contractor (the “principal”) and a second party (the “surety” or “sureties”) to assure fulfillment of the principal's obligations to a third party (the “obligee” or “government”) identified in the bond. If the principal's obligations are not met, the bond assures payment, to the extent stipulated, of any loss sustained by the obligee. Whether for service-type contracts or construction, bonding levels assure the U.S. government that prospective contractors are capable of fulfilling its requirements.
- **Geographic Area Served:** When entering your geographic area, you are stating your organization can go and work as a contractor where there is a FEMA-declared disaster area and you will be able to provide disaster response services.

How Do I Search the Disaster Response Registry?

1. Navigate to SAM.gov.
2. Select the “Sign In” button in the upper right corner. Select “Accept” to accept the US Government System terms.
3. After selecting “Accept,” the system will re-direct you to login.gov.
4. Enter your login.gov credentials and select “Sign In.” The system may prompt you to enter a one-time security code. (You will receive this code via the authentication method you selected during account creation.)
Note: If you do not already have a Login.gov account, please create an account.
5. After signing in, Login.gov will re-direct you to your SAM.gov workspace.

Search SAM.gov to View the Disaster Response Registry

1. From your Workspace, select “Home” from the upper menu.
2. Select “Entity Registration” from the main page.
3. Select “Advanced Search” above the magnifying glass on the search bar.
4. In the filter box on the left, under “Select Domain” select “Disaster Response Registry.”
5. The results page will load. Use the filter box to reduce the number of results.
6. Use filters to create an advanced search. Once applied, filters will appear in boxes; remove filters by selecting the “x” icon on each one:
 - **Keywords:** Apply any keyword searches to your filter.
 - **Entity:** Business Name, Unique Entity Identifier, or CAGE code.
 - **Geographic Region:** Any State, Search by States, or Counties by State.
 - **Purpose of Registration:** All Awards, Assistance Only, IGT, etc.
 - **Entity Type:** Government, Entity, Partnership, etc.
 - **Socio-Economic Status:** Veteran Owned, Minority Owned, etc.
 - **Product or Service Information:** PSC or NAICS Code
 - **Registration with Debt Subject to Offset:** Yes or No.
 - **Location:** ZIP Code, State, Congressional District, etc.
 - **Registration Status:** Active/Inactive.

You can add additional filters by selecting “More Filters” at the bottom of the filter box.

Note: Using the search bar at the top of the page will create a new search and remove any existing filters from your results.
